

Fallen Stock Guidelines

1. When dropping off fallen stock at the kennels, please ensure the book has been filled out correctly and take your copy for your records.
2. Please place the fee for the fallen stock in the money box provided or give it to a member of staff.
3. As from the 1st January 2017 we will not be able to accept cash, either pay by cheque or by Bacs.
4. Please ensure all stock is delivered in by 12pm and within 24 hours of death. All stock to be shot must be brought in on non-hunting days.
5. All fallen stock not suitable for hounds will be charged at the higher rate.
6. Please notify kennels staff if an animal has been disposed of by lethal injection or has been treated with a long course of antibiotics.
